The outcome of the Civil War had a profound impact on the course of democracy, preserving the Union while at the same time liberating an enslaved minority. However, the war was not defined by glamorous ideals but rather by bloody battles and tough decisions. You will be assigned one of the 19 topics from the list above and will create a four slide minimum presentation (excluding the title slide and works cited slide) on that particular topic. If you are assigned a battle from the Civil War your PowerPoint should include the following elements in order to receive full points:

NOTE: YOU MUST ANSWER EACH QUESTION WITHIN YOUR SLIDE

1. The significance of the battle: Why was the battle important to the outcome of the Civil War? Did the battle change how people thought about the war?
2. The significant figures: Who were the significant figures that were involved in the battle? What type of strategy was employed by the generals in order to win the battle?
3. The outcome of the battle: Who won? Why did that particular side win? How many casualties were there? How many people actually fought in the battle?
4. Significant dates: When was the battle? What were two major battles that occurred before that might have had an effect on it? What was a significant event that occurred within a year after this battle?

NOTE: YOU MUST ANSWER EACH QUESTION WITHIN YOUR SLIDE

If you are not assigned a battle then your PowerPoint should answer the following questions:

1. The importance of your event: Why was this event important to either the Civil War or the Reconstruction Period? How did this event change people perspective on either the Civil War or the Reconstruction Period?
2. The significant figures: Who were the significant figures that were involved in your event? What groups of people were affected(African Americans, Women, Union, Confederates?)
3. The outcome of your event: What were the details of your events? What was the outcome of your event?
4. Significant dates: When was your event? What were two major events that occurred before yours that might have had an effect on it? What was an important event that occurred within a year after your event(something that may have had relevance to your event)
