Example: The young man jumped on the boat.

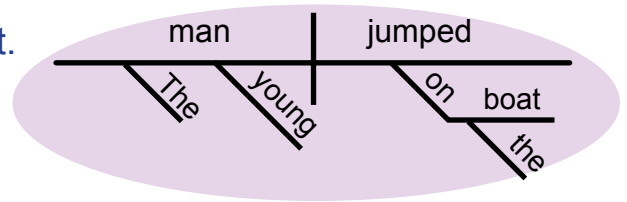
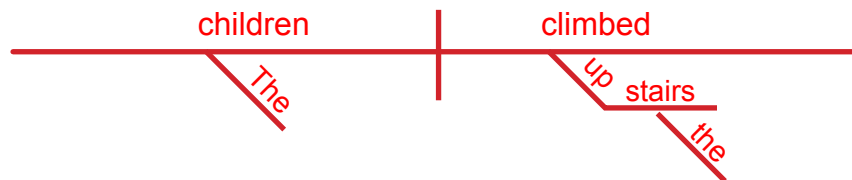


Diagram each sentence below.

1. A happy dog ran down the street.



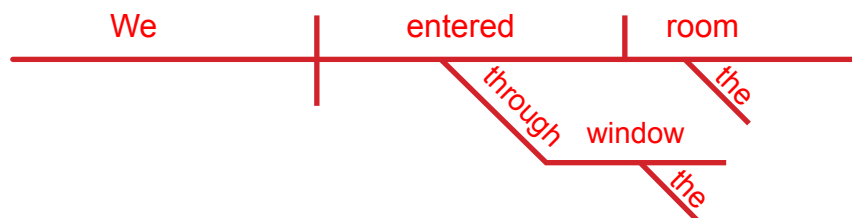
2. The children climbed up the stairs.
