Bases Answers in Text	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Because I viewed each website closely, I could give one or two specific examples of quotes or images from each source as I was discussing them. • I compared or contrasted specific parts of one website to specific parts of another website. • I understood the overall idea of each website, and I used this understanding to inform the discussion. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I talked accurately about the overall gist of the sources we viewed, and I could recall a few specific details. • I compared and contrasted general ideas from website to general ideas from another website (i.e., I understood they were both against global warming). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I talked accurately about the general gist of the subject of each website. • I did not use specific words, images, or sounds from the websites to support my comments. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I was drifting in and out of paying attention while I was watching the sources, and consequently I did not mention examples from them in my discussion comments.
