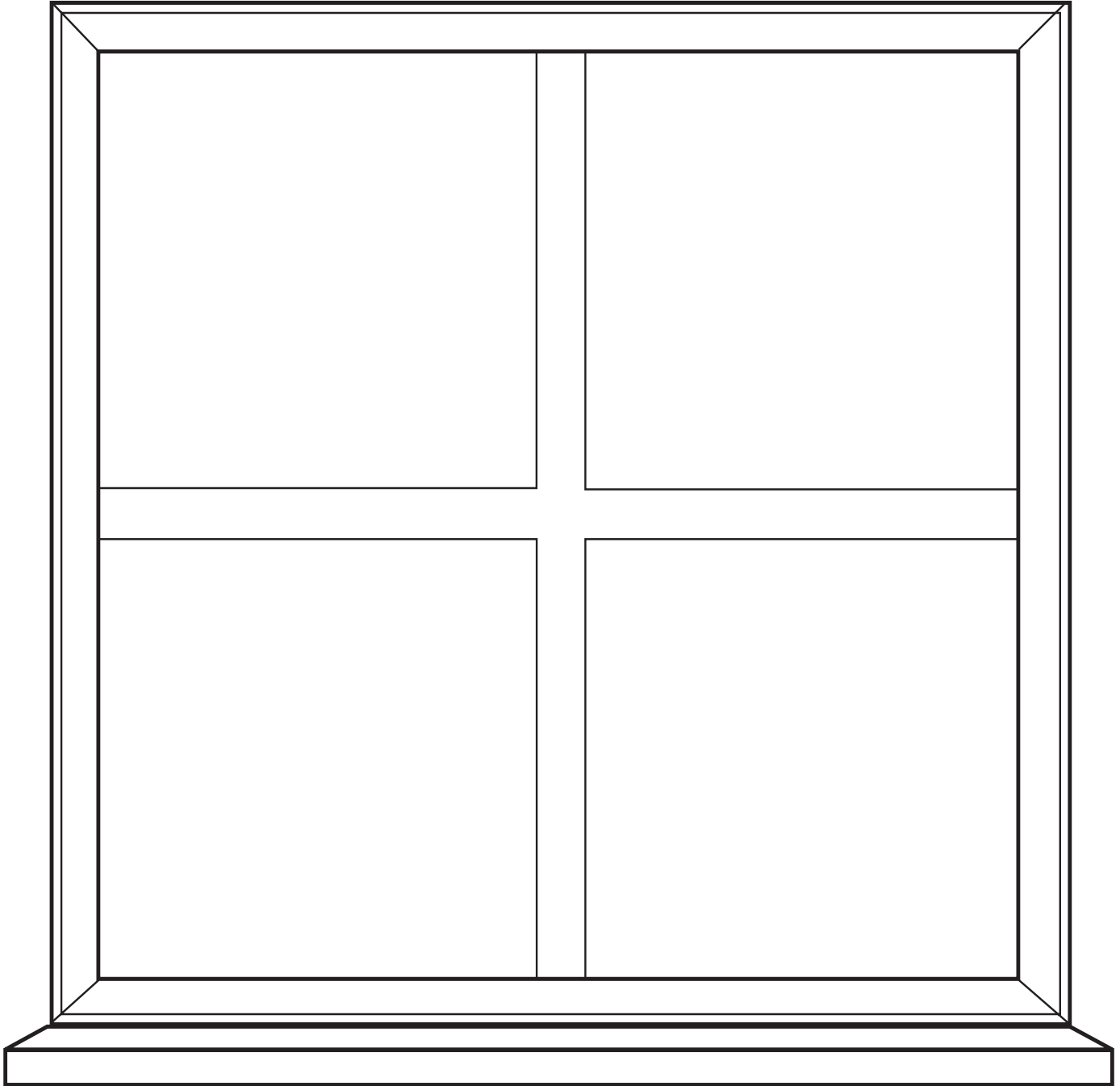


A Scenic View
