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## Topic: The Toulmin Writing Model – Claim and Clarification

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## Do Now

**BACKGROUND:** Yesterday we briefly discussed the first two steps in the Toulmin writing model – CLAIM and CLARIFICATION. Below are examples of each in response to this argumentative writing prompt:

**PROMPT:** The school year should be year-round.

**CLAIM (AGREE):** I believe the school year should be year-round.

**CLARIFICATION (AGREE):** By year-round I mean having school for part of every month of the year will ensure better content retention and development of successful habits in students.

**CLAIM (DISAGREE):** I do not believe the school should be year-round.

**CLARIFICATION (DISAGREE):** Instead, students should have two months off during the summer to concentrate on extracurricular activities and relax for the upcoming school year.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Now that you have reviewed these concepts, **write your own PROMPT, CLAIM, and CLARIFICATION.** You only need to write one CLAIM and one CLARIFICATION for the PROMPT.

• **CLAIM**

○ State your position

- **SAMPLE CLAIM:** I believe the school year should be year-round.

• **CLARIFICATION**

○ Explain your position

- **SAMPLE CLARIFICATION:** By year-round I mean having school for part of every month of the year will ensure better content retention and development of successful habits in students.

• **EVIDENCE**

○ Support your claim with specific details/reasons

- **SAMPLE EVIDENCE:** Students would remember the content quicker if they go on a summer break that last two weeks, than if they were to go on one that lasted two months.
