## Multiple Multiple Meaning Words!

These sentences have more than one multiple meaning word. Find them, and discuss their meanings. Create other sentences with multiple multiple meaning words.

Use your hand to hand it to me.  
 I heard a story about a three story house.  
 My pet dog loves it when you pet him.  
 My light, bright friend used her bright light.  
 He didn't mind that I changed my mind.

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## Nonsense Sentences – Why are these funny?

The ocean waved at me. The phone had a diamond ring.  
 I tape recorded the gift. Stamp your feet on the letter.  
 Summer is my favorite season and salt is my least favorite.  
 I glued the papers together with a stick.  
 My family is taking a trip next week on a banana peel.

Can you make up some nonsense sentences with bark, trip, etc.?
