

French Revolution Framework

Define the three key conditions that led to the French peoples' struggle for power and rights.

CONDITIONS

Conditions in France that angered the French people, before 1789

BELIEFS

The Enlightenment thinkers' beliefs that inspired French people to believe that they deserved to have power and rights, as well as a new government

TRIGGER

The opportunity to struggle against a leader, or a triggering event that caused tensions to erupt in France in 1789
