Goals & Objectives

At the end of this unit, students will be able to:

- Understand the industrial revolution and some of the new inventions that came from it.
- Describe how the industrial revolution affected social life, and led to the birth of socialist theory.
- Define nationalism.
- Understand the unifications of Italy and Germany.
- Describe imperialism in Africa and Asia by European powers, as well as Japanese imperialism in Asia.
