

Worksheet for Citing Web Publications

1. The name of the AUTHOR of the page (very often, you won't find one).

Last name + comma

First name

Initials (if any)

2. The title of the WORK or DOCUMENT (usually at the top of the page). *Put this in quotation marks.*

3. The title of the overall WEB SITE (this is usually at the top of the HOME PAGE). *Put this in italics.*

4. The name of the PUBLISHER OR SPONSOR of the site (the group responsible for the creation of the site—a school, an organization, a corporation, a government agency, etc.). *If not available, use N.p.*

5. Date of publication (day, month, and year, if available). *If not available, use n.d*
