

Q: Were forms of art other than monumental bronze and marble sculpture, painting, and architecture produced in the classical period?

A: Yes. Though monumental sculpture, architecture, and painting are the most imposing and influential mediums, a whole range of modes of expression were used. Smaller statuettes and figurines were made in clay and in bronze. Metal vessels and bowls were decorated with scenes in relief. In fact, many objects made of clay and metal were ornamented with figural relief. Gold jewelry was also produced.
