

Q: Did Etruscan sculpture emulate Greek perfectionism in the modeling of the human figure?

A: Though Etruscan art was much influenced by Greek art, there was less emphasis on the detailed modeling of the human figure. In Greek sculpture, every part of the sculpture was usually considered as an integral part of the whole, while in Etruscan sculpture, certain areas of the figure could be more summarily modeled than others.
